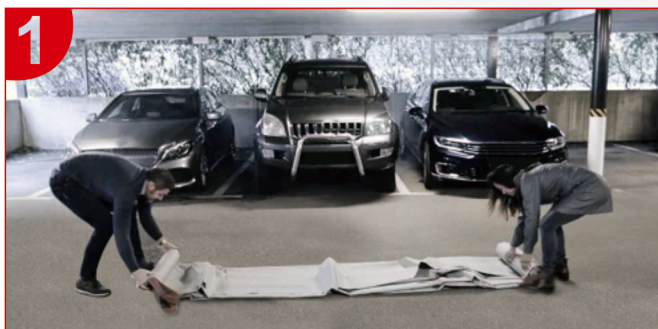

How To Use

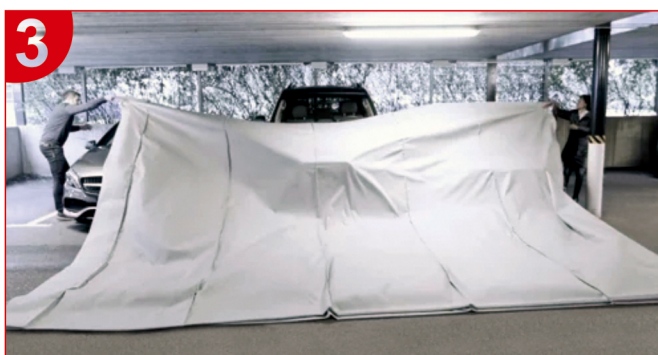
Handled By Two People
